1 in 37 people alive today in the UK will be diagnosed with Parkinson's in their lifetime.

Parkinson's progresses relentlessly becoming increasingly debilitating over time. There is no cure and no test for diagnosis, highlighting the urgent need to better understand what goes wrong and leads to Parkinson's disease.

Today's guest speaker on Have We Got Planning News For You, Marc van Grieken has now lived with Parkinson's for some 17 years. He is also a 'patient advocate' and fundraiser.
